



Part of Moshe's instructions to the spies contained the following phrases:

בְּמֵה־הוּא • וּבְמֵה־הָאָרֶץ • וּבְמֵה־הָעָרִים

The MEM of MA gets a PATACH before a HEI-CHIRIK, but a KAMATZ before a HEI-KAMATZ or a HEI-SEGOL

Another TBD&TR - a review: וְהִיִּיתֶם - This word takes practice to say it properly. Any HEI in the middle of a word that has a SH'VA under it, the SH'VA is NACH and the HEI sounds just like a MAPIK-HEI at the end of a word. The HEI is sounded but no vowel sound to it. First syllable is VIHHH, then YI-TEM.
(Not VI-H'YITEM).
