The Hebrew word for 100 is MEI'A, with the accent and the last (second) syllable (MILRA). mei'A.

As in mei-A sha-NA, mei-A v'es-RIM, mei-A sh'a-RIM.

In this week's sedra, we find an exception. MEI-a CHE-sef, 100 silver (somethings). Since KE-sef is MIL'EIL, the accent on mei-A recedes to MEI-a. This is called NASOG ACHOR.
