

## Hidden in the Sand

D'varim 25:13-14 contain the prohibitions of false weights and measures. The combined gimatriya of these p'sukim is 1514.

T'hilim 119:72 states TOV LI TORAT PICHA... The Torah of Your mouth is better for me than thnds of pieces of gold and silver.

Observing the mitzva of honest weights and measures testifies to the truth of the pasuk in T'hilim. Same gimatriya

This week, the quadrilateral

### QUADRILATERAL

A polygon with four sides.

### **M'RUBA • מְרֻבָּע**

That's the term for any four-sided closed figure. Not to be confused with the word

### **SQUARE = RIBU'A • רִבּוּעַ**

Notice that both has the same root **רבע**

### **RECTANGLE = MALBEIN • מַלְבֵּיין**

### **Parallelogram = מִקְבִּילִית**
