**Word of the Month** Those who follow Minhag Yerushalayim for Kiddush L'vana (first op 3 full days after the Molad with no delay) probably said KL after breaking their Tzom Gedalya fast. The rest of the Jewish world traditionally waits until after Yom Kippur (no need to break their fast first). Either way, the last op for KL of Tishrei is Wednesday night, October 4th - Leil Chag. Although we usually do not say KL on Friday night or on Yom Tov, if the last opportunity falls on Leil Shabbat or Chag, we may (should) say KL. (If one lives where it is usually cloudy and/or rainy at this time of the year, he should not delay KL.)
