...וַיַּעֲשֶׂה לּוֹ כְּתֹנֶת פָּסִים: • ...וַיִּטְבְּלוּ אֶת־הַכְּתֹנֶת בַּדָּם:

And he made for him a K'TONET PASIM (a striped coat, a multi-colored coat).

And they dipped the KUTONET in the blood.

The word **כתנת** occurs eight times in Parshat Vayeishev - more than anywhere else in the Torah. (In T'tzaveh, we find it 5 times, with the garments of the kohanim.)

Note that the first time (on the right, above), the KAF has a SH'VA under it. The second one has a KUBUTZ under the KAF.

The stand-alone word is KUTONET, with a KUBUTZ. The word in its S'MICHUT (connecting) form is K'TONET.

In VAYEITZEI: K'TONET PASIM once, K'TONET HAPASIM twice, K'TONET YOSEF, K'TONET BINCHA (your son's KUTONET), K'TONET B'NE (my son's) - all connecting to the following word. OTOH - KUTANTO, his KUTONET, and HAKUTONET.

Gimatria Match

B'reishit 39:16 - "She kept his garment with her until his master came home."

Yosef was in trouble and he knew it. Yet he maintained his Torah values and principles despite of how much easier it would have been to give in to the advances of Potifar's wife.

D'varim 39:29 ...אשריך ישראל מי כמוך
That's who we are. (Same gimatriya)
