The first pasuk above - from our sedra - speaks to our giving of our possessions to G-d. The second pasuk, of what we are required to give to the poor and the stanger (or convert). Both are important, not because the two p'sukim have the same gimatriya (3510), but because of our obligations BEIN ADAM LAMAKOM and BEIT ADAM L'CHAVEIRO.
