Previous (Tzav) TTriddles:

[1] FPTL: Did Mordechai really know all Ashers?

In a search for a Gimatriya match for 1316, the first 5 words of Esther 4:1 came up. They are a partial pasuk which literally translates to "And Mordechai knew all ASHER":

= 6 + 40+200+4+20+10 (280) +
10+4+70 (84) + 1+400 (401) +20+30
(50) + 1+300+200 (501) = 1316.

[2] Page footer icons

The icon on the left is a piece of fabric from the Mishkan and the icon on the right is a matzah because of the repeated reminders in the parsha that menachot are not allowed to be Chometz; they are made with matza rules.

[3] SBB (Sedra Box Background)

The repeated reference to Menachot being not Chometz is the reason we chose Matza as the background to the Sedra box. During a one Adar year Tzav is always Shabbat HaGadol giving it an extra connection to the content of the sedra.
