What other sedras besides Tzav have the Torah note SHALSHELET on one of its words?

**[5] It's more TZAV than TZAV**

Old one. Tzav (=96) has 96 p'sukim. Except it doesn't; it has 97. T'rumah has 96 p'sukim, making it more Tzav than Tzav.
