Previous (SH'LACH) TTriddles:

[1] **FPTL: TT, my boy, how old are you?**

Celebrating 26 years of Torah Tidbits, the 26th anniversary had a FPTL TTriddle with a question. The answer in Hebrew is BEN ESRIM VASHEISH (26 years old). $2+50$ (52) $70+300+200+10+40$ (620) + $6+300+300$ (606) = 1278.

[2] **Shimon, Yissachar, Naftali, Gad**

These four tribes sent spies (scouts) whose names began with the same letter as the tribe. SHAFAT from Shimon, YIG'AL from Yissachar, NACHBI from Naftali, and G'U'EIL from Gad.

[3] **What do fathers of Yig'al and Nachbi share?**

Yig'al ben YOSEF and Nachbi ben VOFSI - their fathers share the same letters in their names. YOSEF and VOFSI are anagrams.

[4] **MazalPic**

HORSESHOE. The mazal of Tamuz is Cancer, the Crab. Sartan, in Hebrew. The horseshoe crab (a.k.a. King Crab) is a large marine arthropod with a domed horseshoe-shaped shell, a long tail-spine (mostly used to flip itself upright if the need arises), ten legs and ten eyes. Horseshoe crabs are extremely important to the biomedical industry because their unique, copper-based blue blood... which contains a valuable substance.
